Our records indicate that you have failed to acquire the twelve (12) continuing legal education hours required for the reporting period ending June 30, 2026. Accordingly, you are not in compliance with Rule 3(a) of the Arkansas Rules for Minimum Continuing Legal Education.

To avoid suspension of your attorney's license, you must sign this Acknowledgement of Deficiency form and pay the mandatory \$75 deficiency fee. Doing so will extend your deadline to **December 1, 2026**, to cure your CLE deficiency.

Missing credit hours on your transcript? If your CLE hours were completed **on or before June 30, 2026**, email your certificates to clearkansas@arcourts.gov. Once verified, your account will be adjusted and the deficiency fee removed. CLE completed on or after July 1, 2026, does not satisfy the reporting deadline and remains subject to the deficiency fee.

The \$75 deficiency fee may be paid through your personal attorney portal on the Arkansas Judiciary website here <https://attorneyinfo.aoc.arkansas.gov/info> or pay online through the Clerk's Office payment site at ar.gov/attorney, selecting "**Other**" and noting "**CLE Fee.**"

Checks or money orders, payable to the **Bar of Arkansas**, may also be mailed with this signed Acknowledgement of Deficiency form to the address listed above.

Your signed Acknowledgement of Deficiency form and \$75 deficiency fee must be received **no later than August 31, 2026**. Failure to meet this deadline may result in suspension of your attorney's license.
