1. **JUDGE:** The 34th State District Court is served by one state district judge. The judge serves in the designated departments of the court as follows:

2. **COURT:** Sessions of court are generally scheduled as follows:

Rison Department	First and third Thursdays of each month, 9:00a.m.
Fordyce Department	Second and fourth Thursdays of each month, 9:00a.m.
Sparkman Department	Second Tuesday of each month, 9:00a.m.
All Departments	Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays are reserved for special hearings, including first appearances, and trials.

3. **TYPES OF CASES:** The following cases are heard at these locations:

Hampton Department	Traffic offenses, criminal offenses, small claims cases, and civil cases.

and civic cases.


Fordyce Department Traffic offenses, criminal offenses, small claims cases,

4. WARRANT DOCKET: A warrant docket within the criminal division has been established.
5. REFERRALS FROM CIRCUIT COURT: Matters pending in Circuit Court currently referred to District Court are felony warrants of arrest, search warrants, and first appearances of defendants for felonious conduct.
6. DIGITAL AUDIO RECORDING EQUIPMENT: Digital audio recording equipment is not currently required.
7. SPECIALITY COURTS: There are currently no specialty courts in the District.
8. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Administrative Plan is effective January 1, 2026.
