

Background and Definitions

Recognizing the potential financial savings and social benefits of drug courts, Arkansas expanded from one (1) drug court in 1994 to 36 by June 2006. Almost all courts require extensive supervision, drug testing, individual therapy, group therapy, employment and/or community service. Drug testing is generally random and can be done as frequently as daily; although most perform the tests on new court participants up to 3 times per week.

This report examines the results of random drug test specimens given by participants in the drug court programs across the state. Demographic information regarding court participants is provided. In addition, the number of specimens tested and the results of each specimen is reported for each court.

- <u>Clients</u> represents the number of unique offenders who were tested by the court. A client could be tested repeatedly over a period of time but would still be counted only once.
- <u>Specimens</u> represents the number of samples given by any one offender. An offender may have multiple specimens taken. For example, an offender tested twice a week for 10 weeks would have 20 unique specimens that would undergo analysis.
- Each specimen may be tested for multiple drugs, up to 7 different illegal substances. From these tests, we are able to obtain the number of <u>positive substance results</u> for a drug type which would show the type of drugs generally available or being used by drug court participants in a community. For example, a single offender (client count) over a two week period may be tested 7 times (7 specimens). Each specimen may be tested for up to 7 different drugs for a total of 49 drug assays.

Positive testing rates are obtained from the number of specimens testing positive for at least one drug. However, when reporting the drugs for which clients test positive, all positive tests are counted, even if the two or more positive substances came from the same specimen. As a measure of performance, DCC tracks any positive <u>specimen</u> since we are tracking offender's use of any substance. If one offender was tested 7 times and one of the tests had reported a positive result for one or more substances, the percentage of positive specimen results would be 1 out of 7 (14.3%).

Drug Testing Assays and Results

The testing panel for drug assays – the testing procedure to determine the amount of a particular substance in the urine – can vary by court or area, not all courts test for all 7 substances.

Methamphetamine is a substance in the amphetamine group of drugs, much like beer is a substance in the group known as alcohol. Some court areas test for amphetamines, knowing that methamphetamine will show a positive result in this category. In these courts, there may not be any reported methamphetamine results.

There are a few tests included in the report that indicate a false positive. This means that while the first analysis of a specimen was positive for an illegal chemical substance, a second analysis was negative.



During the fiscal year, it would have been possible for an offender to have their drug court case transferred to another court program. In these cases, the offender is counted only once under clients tested when compiling a statewide total of offenders tested. On the court specific reports that follow, the offender would be reported in any court that performed a test on that offender.

During fiscal year 2006, 1, 963 offenders were tested in Arkansas drug courts. These offenders provided 64,456 specimens for testing, approximately 33 specimens for each offender.


























