## ORDER

Circuit Judge Gordon Webb, of the 14<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Judge Webb is working through a heavy docket in Baxter County, which will conflict with a two week criminal jury trial in the circuit on the same day. Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, and Arkansas Constitution Amendment 80, and in response to Judge Webb’s written request dated March 9, 2018, the Hon. David Laser, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 14<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, 4<sup>th</sup> Division, to sit on the following date and place:

March 22, 2018 in Baxter County

On that date, Judge Laser will assume Judge Webb’s regularly-scheduled criminal docket while Judge Webb presides over the two week criminal trial in Boone County in the same circuit.
