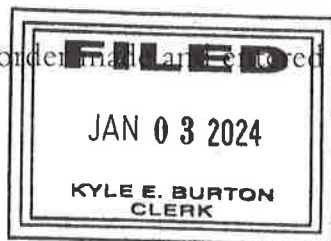
## ORDER


Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” the Hon. Chris Carnahan, State District Court Judge, Faulkner County and Van Buren County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, 4<sup>th</sup> Division, to sit on the following dates:

August 6, 2024  
November 20-21, 2024

The assignment of Judge Carnahan to the 20<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Faulkner County and Van Buren County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Carnahan to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
