## ORDER

Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Crittenden County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Tom Wynne, State District Court Judge, 34<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, Calhoun County, Cleveland County and Dallas County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Jefferson County District Court, Pine Bluff Department, to hear the following case:

*St. Louis University d/b/a Slucare v. Amanda Thomas-Motsinger – PBCV-22-193*


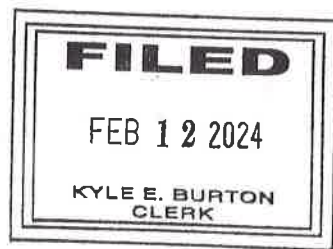
The assignment of Judge Wynne to the Jefferson County District Court, Pine Bluff Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Jefferson County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection

with said cause, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Wynne.

The assignment of Judge Wynne to the Jefferson County District Court, Pine Bluff Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Calhoun County, Cleveland County, and Dallas County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Wynne to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
