## ORDER


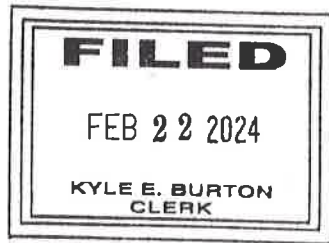
Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Crittenden County District Court Clerk, West Memphis Department, the Hon. Jason Carter, 22<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District Court, Lee County and Phillips County District Court is hereby assigned to the Crittenden County District Court, West Memphis Department, to hear the following case:

*State of Arkansas v. Myles Christian Huff*– WMS-24-81

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Carter.
