## ORDER

Circuit Judge Herb Wright, of the 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Judge Wright is scheduled to hear his regularly-scheduled docket in Perry County on September 4 and 18, 2018 and will also be conducting criminal jury trials in Pulaski County on the same days. Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Arkansas Constitution Amendment 80, and in response to Judge Wright’s written request, Judge Russell Rogers, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 6<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, 4<sup>th</sup> Division, to sit on the following dates and location:

September 4 and 18, 2018 in Perryville

On those dates, Judge Rogers will preside over the regularly-scheduled docket in Perry County while Judge Wright presides over the criminal jury trials in Pulaski County.
