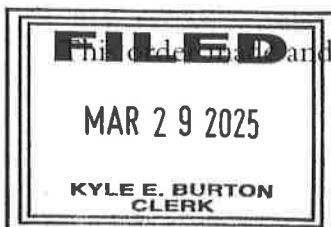
## ORDER

Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Crittenden County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Richard Proctor, Retired District Court Judge, is hereby assigned to the Crittenden County District Court, Marion Department, to hear the following case:

*State of Arkansas v. Gregory Lackey* – ONC-25-391

The assignment of Judge Proctor to the Crittenden County District Court, Marion Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date, due to the Crittenden County District Judge's recusal.
