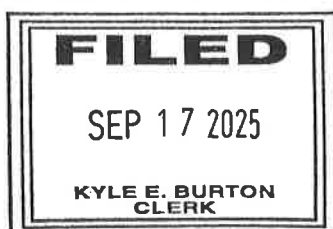
ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” the Hon. Andy Gill, of the 6th Judicial Circuit, 9th Division, is hereby assigned to the Perry County District Court, Perryville Department, to sit on the following date:

September 18, 2025

The assignment of Judge Gill to the Perry County District Court, Perryville Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the 6th Judicial Circuit, 9th Division, shall remain in Judge Gill to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
