City of Searcy v. James A. Simpson – SEC-25-2261; SEC-25-2262

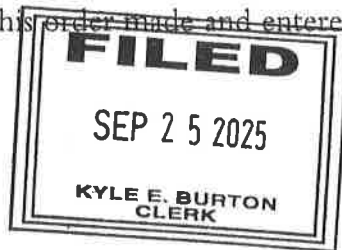
