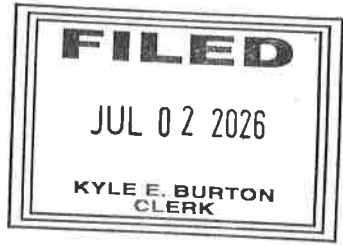
State of Arkansas v. Quinton R. Brown CR-26-209
