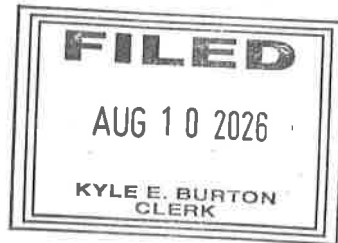
State of Arkansas v. Clinton Ray Hardin TYC-26-8
