ORDER

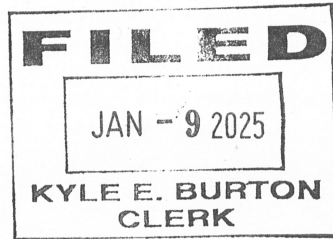
Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Amendment 80 §13 (C) to the Arkansas Constitution and Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, the Chief Justice has found that there is a need for a special judge to be assigned and in the interest of judicial economy, the anticipated hardship on the parties to switch judges, and the judge's extensive experience with the case, Judge Herbert Wright, State District Court Judge, 31st Judicial District Court, Little Rock District Court, Division 2, is hereby assigned to the 6th Judicial Circuit to hear the following case:

Pulaski County Circuit Court Case No. 60CV-22-4560

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said cause, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Wright.

The assignment of Judge Wright to the 6th Judicial Circuit, Pulaski County, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Little Rock District Court, Division 2, shall remain in Judge Wright to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
