State of Arkansas v. Cornelius Branch, Jr. – ADS-24-529


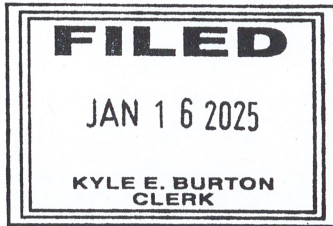
State of Arkansas v. Donnie Lee Deaton – ADS-24-530
