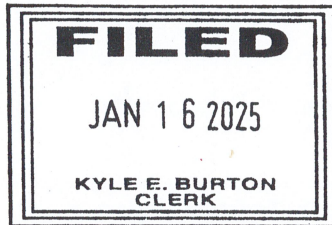
Sevier County v. Jose Enrique Camacho – CR-24-1601


