Milas H. “Butch” Hale, 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial District Court, Sherwood District Court, is hereby assigned to the Saline County District Court, Benton Department, to hear the following case:

*State of Arkansas v. Kimberly Ford – Citation No. 1A0A1685747*

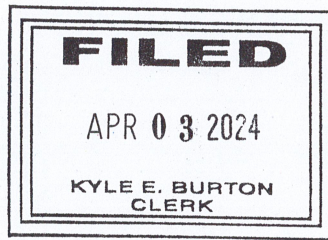


This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Hale.

The assignment of Judge Hale to the Saline County District Court, Benton Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Sherwood District Court, shall remain in Judge Hale to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
