ORDER

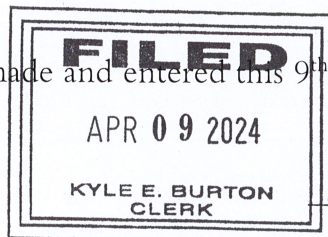


State of Arkansas v. Dayton Alexander Myers – HTC-23-5040
