Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Pope County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Charles Clawson, State District Court Judge, 9th Judicial District Court, Faulkner County and Van Buren County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Pope County District Court, Russellville Department, to hear the following case:


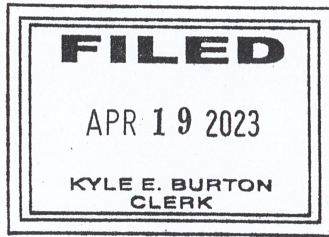
Dominic Noteboom v. Angelia Thornsberry – SC-23-33

The assignment of Judge Clawson to the Pope County District Court, Russellville Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Pope County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Clawson.

The assignment of Judge Clawson to the Pope County District Court, Russellville Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Faulkner County and Van Buren County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Clawson to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
