ORDER

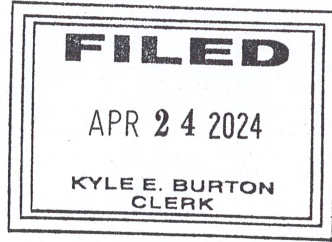


