*State of Arkansas v. Miranda Gibson* – GWDC-ST-20247-02460

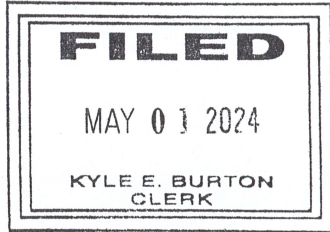



Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Crawford County District Court, shall remain in Judge Baker to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
