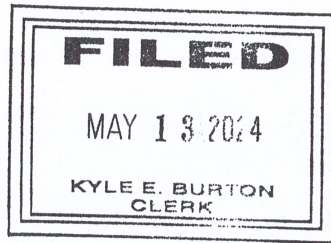
State of Arkansas v. James Alderman – WAAW-24-4


The assignment of Judge Grimes to the Scott County District Court, Waldron Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Scott County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said cause, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Grimes.

The assignment of Judge Grimes to the Scott County District Court, Waldron Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Sebastian County District Court, Fort Smith Department, Division 1, shall remain in Judge Grimes to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
