Henry Boyce, State District Court Judge, 15th Judicial District Court, Jackson County and Woodruff County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the St. Francis County District Court, Forrest City Department, to hear the following cases:

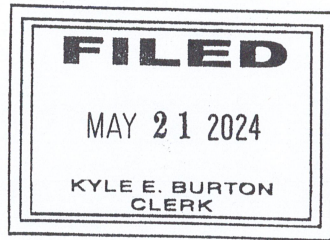

CR-24-2983; CR-24-2984


The assignment of Judge Boyce to the St. Francis County District Court, Forrest City Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the St. Francis County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Boyce.

The assignment of Judge Boyce to the St. Francis County District Court, Forrest City Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Jackson County and Woodruff County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Boyce to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
