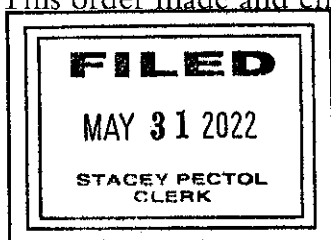
ORDER

Circuit Judge Donna Galloway has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Judge Galloway has jury trials scheduled in Arkansas County, Southern District, as well as jury trials in the Northern District in the same county. Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge David Henry, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 11th East Judicial Circuit, Northern District, to sit on the following dates:

June 7, 8, 9 and 10, 2022

On those dates, Judge Henry will preside over trials scheduled in Stuttgart while Judge Galloway presides over jury trials in DeWitt.
