ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Hon. Alex Bigger, 11th Judicial District Court, Lawrence County, Randolph County and Sharp County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Craighead County District Court, Jonesboro Department, to hear the following cases:

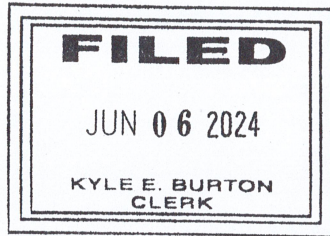
City of Jonesboro v. Alexis Ellison - JOC-18-1451; JOC-23-9630


City of Jonesboro v. Elizabeth Rook - JOC-22-8916

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Bigger.

The assignment of Judge Bigger to the Craighead County District Court, Jonesboro Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Lawrence County, Randolph County and Sharp County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Bigger to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
