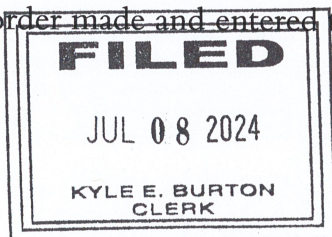
## ORDER


Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” the Hon. Teresa Smith, State District Court Judge, 30<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, Lonoke County District Court, Division 1, is hereby assigned to the 23<sup>rd</sup> Judicial Circuit, 1<sup>st</sup> Division, to sit on the following date:

July 8, 2024 (morning only)

The assignment of Judge Smith to the 23<sup>rd</sup> Judicial Circuit entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Lonoke County District Court, Division 1, shall remain in Judge Smith to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
