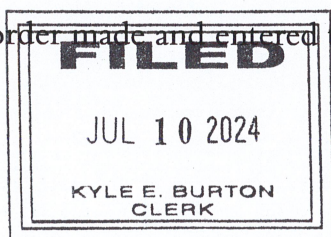
ORDER



Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge William R. Wright (Bar #78176), Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 5th Judicial Circuit, 1st Division, to sit on the following date:

August 14, 2024

On that date, Judge Wright will preside over domestic relations cases scheduled in Pope County and Judge Dunham will preside over a criminal jury trial that is scheduled for the same day in Pope County within the same circuit.
