**ORDER**

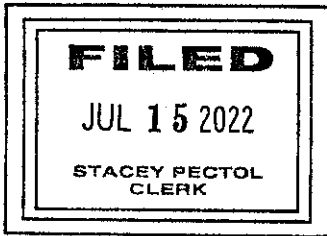


the following case:
