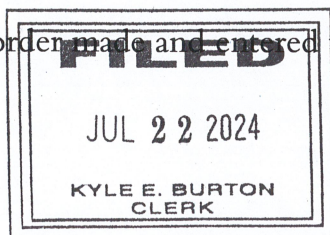

Sherry D. Burnett, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the Garland County District Court, Hot Springs Department, to hear the following case:

State of Arkansas v. Joshua Shane Daniels – HTS-23-4284
