The assignment of Judge Carnahan to the Cleburne County District Court, Quitman Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Cleburne County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said cause, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Carnahan.

The assignment of Judge Carnahan to the Cleburne County District Court, Greers

Ferry Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Faulkner County and

Van Buren County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Carnahan to the same extent as
though this assignment had not been made.
