Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Bradley County District Court Clerk, Warren Department, the Hon. Tom Wynne, State District Court Judge, 34th Judicial District Court, Calhoun County, Cleveland County and Dallas County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Bradley County District Court, Warren Department, to hear the following cases:

Bradley County v. Mark Vickers – CR22-584

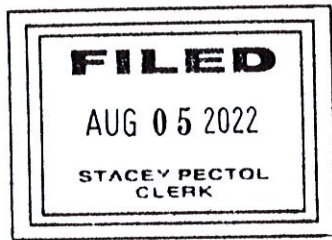
The assignment of Judge Wynne to the Bradley County District Court, Warren Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date, due to the Bradley County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Wynne.

The assignment of Judge Wynne to the Bradley County District Court, Warren Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Calhoun County, Cleveland County and Dallas County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Wynne to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
