State of Arkansas v. Jodie Coulter – O-24-2645

The assignment of Judge Smith to the Mississippi County District Court, Osceola Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Mississippi County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection

with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Smith.

The assignment of Judge Smith to the Mississippi County District Court, Osceola Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the St. Francis County District Court, shall remain in Judge Smith to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
