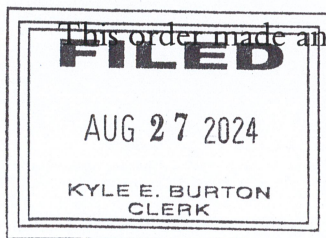
ORDER

Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Franklin County District Court Clerk, the Hon. David Stewart, Retired District Court Judge, is hereby assigned to the Franklin County District Court, Ozark Department, to hear the following case:

City of Clarksville v. John Troub – OZC-23-529

The assignment of Judge Stewart to the Franklin County District Court, Ozark Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date, due to the Franklin County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Stewart.
