City of West Memphis v. Christina Williams – WMC-24-1733


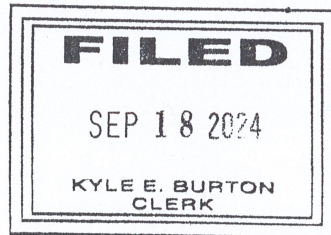

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Dean.

The assignment of Judge Dean to the Crittenden County District Court, West Memphis Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Mississippi County District Court, Osceola Department, shall remain in Judge Dean to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
