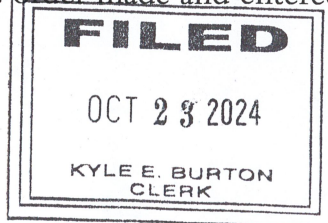
ORDER


Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” the Hon. Charles Baker, State District Court Judge, 5th Judicial District Court, Crawford County District Court, is hereby assigned to the Franklin County District Court, Charleston Department, to sit on the following date:

November 7, 2024 in Ozark

The assignment of Judge Baker to the Franklin County District Court, Charleston Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Crawford County District Court, shall remain in Judge Baker to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
