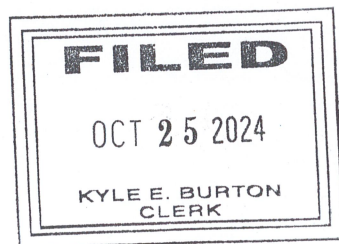
ORDER

Circuit Judge James Dunham has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge William R. Wright (Bar #78176), Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 5th Judicial Circuit, 1st Division, to sit on the following dates:
