ORDER

Circuit Judge Cindy Thyer, of the 2nd Judicial Circuit, has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Judge Thyer has a murder trial scheduled the week of December 9, 2019 in Craighead County, Western District, which will conflict with her regularly scheduled civil docket in Mississippi County, Southern District, in the circuit on the same days. Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge David Laser, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 2nd Judicial Circuit, 4th Division, to sit on the following date and location:

December 13, 2019 in Osceola

On that date, Judge Laser will assume Judge Thyer’s regularly-scheduled civil docket while Judge Thyer presides over the murder trial in Craighead County in the

same circuit.
