Tom Wynne, State District Court Judge, 34th Judicial District Court, Calhoun County, Dallas County and Ouachita County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Bradley County District Court, Warren Department, to hear the following cases:

The assignment of Judge Wynne to the Bradley County District Court, Warren Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the court's conflict day due to the Bradley County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Wynne.

The assignment of Judge Wynne to the Bradley County District Court, Warren Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Calhoun County, Dallas County and Ouachita County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Wynne to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
