ORDER

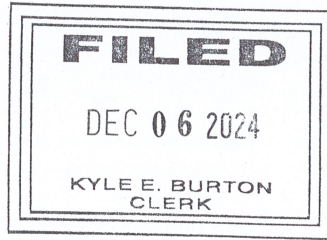


