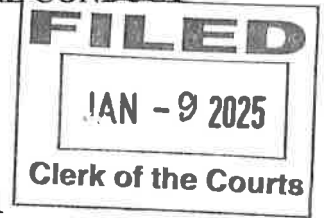

**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT TO THE PRACTICE OF LAW**

1. Pursuant to Section 23 of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (2011), (the "Procedures"), Attorney Stephen Ewing Morley, submitted his Petition for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law. The Petition was considered by Panel A of the Committee on Professional Conduct.

2. Petitioner was suspended for forty-two (42) months by Order of the Committee on Professional Conduct on September 20, 2019. Petitioner did not practice law nor petition for reinstatement until December 9, 2024.

3. By majority vote, Panel A has voted to reinstate Mr Morley to the active practice of law in Arkansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that Petitioner's Petition for Reinstatement be granted and said reinstatement shall become effective upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
