Attorney Wesley John Ketz, Jr., an attorney practicing law primarily in Batesville, Arkansas, Bar ID #96043 has been suspended from the practice of law within the jurisdiction of this State. Mr. Ketz was found guilty by a jury in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas, in Case No. 4:00-CR-187, on March 9, 2004, of the felony criminal offenses of Participating in Racketeering Enterprise (Count 1), Drug Task Force Mail Fraud (Count 14), and Drug Task Force Mail Fraud (Count 15), of the Indictment. The Committee on Professional Conduct suspended Mr. Wesley John Ketz's license to practice law effective March 31, 2004.

Please be advised that a suspended attorney shall not be reinstated to the practice of law in this State until the Arkansas Supreme Court has received an affirmative vote by a majority of the Committee. If, and at such time as the Committee may reinstate the attorney, you will be provided notice of the reinstatement and the effective date thereof.
