Attorney Bob Samuel Castleman, an attorney practicing law primarily in Pocahontas, Arkansas, Bar ID #96043 has been suspended from the practice of law within the jurisdiction of this State for entering a plea of guilty during trial in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas, in Case No. 4:03-CR-169, on January 28, 2004, to the felony criminal offense Aiding and Abetting the Mailing of a Threatening Communication, a violation of 18 United States Code Section 876, being Count 1 of the Indictment. This offense is a felony, punishable by up to five years imprisonment and /or a fine of \$250,000. The Committee on Professional Conduct suspended Bob Samuel Castleman's Arkansas Attorney's License effective March 29, 2004.

Please be advised that a suspended attorney shall not be reinstated to the practice of law in this State until the Arkansas Supreme Court has received an affirmative vote by a majority of the Committee. If, and at such time as the Committee may reinstate the attorney, you will be provided notice of the reinstatement and the effective date thereof.
