



## ARKANSAS ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS COURT SECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

### 2025 GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT

The Administrative Office of the Courts, in cooperation with the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Security and Emergency Preparedness, will award **\$500,000.00** in grants with a maximum award of \$20,000.00 per application/per county, to counties for use by Local Security and Emergency Preparedness Committees for improvements in court security and emergency preparedness in circuit and district courts. Eligible applicants include any counties which have completed all requirements for the submission and approval of their Local Security and Emergency Preparedness Plans including the Facility Assessment, Court Security Plan, Emergency Response Plan, and Continuity of Operations Plan. Each eligible county may submit one application with a maximum award request of \$20,000.00.

Dear Applicants for the Court Security and Emergency Preparedness Grant:

Courtroom security is important to all. As Chairman of the Supreme Court Security and Emergency Preparedness Committee, I wanted to address the lack of reporting of courtroom incidents. The Administrative Office of the Court has established a means of reporting courtroom incidents, and completing and submitting court security incident reports ensures the safety and integrity of the judicial system.

A "court security incident" is defined as any event that threatens the security of a person or property, disrupts court functions, or involves in-court criminal contempt. These incidents include, but are not limited to, threats of harm, disorderly conduct, arrests, physical assaults, escape attempts, or any other security-related disturbances within the court.

Proper documentation of these incidents serves several important purposes:

1. Enhancing Security Measures – By analyzing past incidents, courts can identify patterns and implement necessary security improvements to prevent future threats.
2. Legal and Procedural Accountability – Incident reports provide an official record that may be required for legal proceedings, disciplinary actions, or policy reviews.
3. Protecting Court Personnel and Visitors – Timely reporting ensures that appropriate actions are taken to safeguard judges, attorneys, staff, and the public.
4. Efficient Emergency Response – Reports provide critical information that helps law enforcement, security personnel, and court administration respond effectively to potential threats.

By diligently completing and submitting incident reports, court personnel contribute to a safe, secure, and well-functioning judicial environment. The statistical information alone from the submission of incident reports is invaluable when requesting grant funds and in asking for the support of the legislature and other elected officials. The number and type of courtroom incidents in a given jurisdiction would certainly be a consideration for the committee when reviewing grant applications. Honorable County Judges,

*Friends!*

I wanted to bring to your attention a very simple but beneficial grant that I believe is worth your time to look into.

The Arkansas Administrative Office of the Courts administers a grant program that provides money to improve the safety in and around your circuit and district courts. The exciting news is that the legislature increased funding for this grant from \$250,000 to \$500,000 per year. As a member of the grant selection committee, we are really trying to make a push for all of the counties to get their safety committees going and apply for this money. It really is not that hard. Read the details below, just form a committee, have a meeting, determine what you need to make your facility safer, and turn in the grant request.



- These committees shall be co-chaired by a circuit judge, appointed by the administrative judge, and the county judge. Membership should include a district court judge, city and county executive officers, law enforcement officers, local emergency preparedness officials, and a representative of the public. The specific number and composition of the committee should be determined at the local level.
- Coordinated Security Planning – Regular meetings allow stakeholders to develop and refine security protocols, ensuring a unified approach to emergency preparedness and incident response.
- Enhanced Communication and Collaboration – Bringing together judges, law enforcement, and emergency officials fosters better coordination and a shared understanding of security challenges within the courts.
- Proactive Risk Assessment – Committees can regularly assess potential security threats, address vulnerabilities, and implement preventative measures before incidents occur.
- Efficient Crisis Response – In the event of a security breach or emergency, having a structured committee ensures a swift and organized response, minimizing disruptions and risks.
- Public Confidence and Transparency – Including a public representative helps build trust in the court's commitment to security and emergency preparedness.
- Compliance with Best Practices – Regularly convening these committees aligns local courts with national and state-level security recommendations, ensuring adherence to judicial safety standards.
- By creating and actively engaging in these committees, local courts can enhance security, improve emergency response efforts, and foster a safer judicial environment for all.
